Job Specification

ROLE: Marketing Volunteer

REPORTS TO: Marketing and Communications Coordinator

LOCATION: Wingfield (Founders Building)

SHIFT TIMES: One day per week

Purpose

The Marketing Volunteer will assist the marketing team in the promotion of AWL and its operations, including adoptions, cremations, boarding and thrift shops.

Volunteer Duties and Responsibilities

Duties include:

- Assisting in gathering and editing photo and video content for AWL's social media accounts and website, including:
 - Staff performing day-to-day duties in adoptions, boarding, cremations and thrift shops.
 - Animals in AWL care, including adoptions and boarding (subject to customer approval).
- Assisting in writing engaging marketing copy for social media posts, blog articles and website copy.
- Assisting in designing assets for AWL's social media accounts, website, EDMs and TV screens.

Work Health and Safety

All volunteers have a legal obligation to protect themselves from risks to health and safety and to make sure they do not cause a risk to others through any action or omission.

In particular, the incumbent must:

- Comply with statutory and organisation requirements, procedures and rules introduced to protect the health and safety of people at the workplace including the public.
- Use equipment provided to protect health and safety.
