Laundry Assistant Wingfield

SHIFT TIMES: Part time – 8.30am – 12.30pm

Purpose

The Laundry Assistant provides assistance with the daily duties in the Laundry at the Wingfield shelter.

Volunteer duties and responsibilities

The Volunteer Laundry Assistant will work at the Wingfield Shelter and will be able to:

Duties

- Sorting bedding for animals
- Washing, drying of bedding for animals
- Washing of food dishes, litter trays, toys etc

Organisational

- Attend designated shifts as per the volunteer roster
- Develop and maintain a productive working relationship with the team
- Maintain a high standard of personal presentation
- Maintain confidentiality and privacy in matters relating to the AWL, customers, procedures and security
- Represent AWL in a professional manner at all times in accordance with the Code of Conduct
- Promote a proactive approach to Workplace Health & Safety (WHS) in accordance with the WHS Management System
- Identify hazards, assess risks and report incidents as required in line with the WHS Policy

Work Health and Safety

All workers have a legal obligation to protect themselves from risks to health and safety and to make sure they do not cause a risk to others through any action or omission.

In particular, the incumbent must:

- Comply with statutory and organisation requirements, procedures and rules introduced to protect the health and safety of people at the workplace including the public
- Use equipment provided to protect health and safety

- Working with chemicals
